


Luke 1.37

...The message came to a country preacher in Phillipsburg, PA as he read the Feb 23, 1958 Life magazine story of the Egyptian Kings murder trial in New York City. God's assignment, "Reach these young men. This is your mission, should you chose to accept it..."

The book and movie, <u>The Cross and The Switchblade</u> told the story of David Wilkerson's mission into the concrete jungle of New York City and the conversion of Nicky Cruz, a violent leader of the notorious Mau Mau gang.



From the obedience of one man, the ministry of Teen Challenge was born. David Wilkerson was joined by his brother, Don, as God raised up an army of volunteers, courageous, committed visionaries who carried the TC ministry around the world.

In the last 50 years, Teen Challenge has impacted 108 nations. There are 634 centers in operation worldwide In 2008. We have formal invitations to launch centers in 23 more nations, While resources will be part of planting centers, it always starts with "one," a person ... with a vision.

In 1977, Cathy and I hosted Teen Challenge choir members in our home in Pennsylvania during a David Wilkers on crusade. We had no idea the adventure God had planned for us and our children. We started a re-entry home and God drew us into the Teen Challenge ministry. We have been serving Teen Challenge for 30 years.

In 2008, TC celebrates 50 years of miracles. Even after 5 decades of success, we are still identifying ongoing, cutting edge, culturally relevant strategies to deliver Christ-centered care to centers world-wide harnessing emerging technologies. Global Teen Challenge continues to embrace the mission, core values, and vision that will propel Teen Challenge into the next 50 years. We are prayerfully pursuing strategies to protect the faithbased legacy of miracles that are sy nonymous with The Cross and the Switchblade and the Tenn Challenge Ministry.

As I ministered on five continer in 2007 I saw an emerging arr of men and women who carry the unchanging message of a lichanging God. The book of Deuteronomy speaks of the Year of Jubilee. It comes every 49 years with a declaration

of freedom. The tattooed faces of the soldiers of Mara Salvatrucha, one of the violent gangs of South and Central America, now export their death and drugs to major cities of the USA. I ministered to them in Honduras and El Salvador. Though the faces of gang involvement have changed over the last 50 years, the pain of wounded hearts and the cry to belong at the center of their violence and drug addiction has not. Only Jesus can heal a broken heart, break the cycle of addiction and set the captive FREE. The testimony of their new life inspires faith, as God transforms the hopeless into givers of hope. In Muslim nations, even the Mulahs are crying out for help. In communist nations, leaders are looking past politics to the need. In the face of human trafficking and sexual slavery, courageous Teen Challenge workers are carrying the message of hope onto the streets and brothels of India. This Year of Jubilee comes, not just every 49 years, but every single day around the world because of daring, faithful servants and the sacrificial gifts of partners just like you. We are so grateful for all you have done to send us to teach, train and reach.
