For the first time in fourteen years, all Global Teen Challenge Africa personnel and sister ministries will come together in 2012. Hosted by Jerry Nance, CEO and President of GTC, and Doug Wever, GTC Africa Regional Director, Africa, we want you and your ministry to be a part of this GTC Africa historic event.
