PALAWAN 4: A COVENANT OF LOVE, UNITY AND REDEMPITIVE PURPOSE



It happened like a dream! Palawan 4 Bishops and Leaders' Summit was successfully held at Puerto Princesa City in the so called "The Last Frontier", scenic and beautiful Island of Palawan. Some 96 key bishops and ministry leaders, with some bringing their wives, gathered at Legend Hotel Palawan for the fourth Bishops and Leaders' Summit which they call "Palawan 4". Sponsored by the generous couple Bro. Wyden and Sis. Antonia King, the owners of Legend Palawan, Palawan 4 was hosted by four main conveners namely, Intercessors for the Philippines (IFP), the Philippines for Jesus Movement (PJM), the Philippine Council of Evangelical Churches (PCEC) and the NFS Ministries (NFS). Bishop "Kuya" Dan Balais, the CLSF Senior Pastor and Spiritual Director and concurrently, the National Chairman of IFP, sits as one of the leaders among the conveners together with Pastor Ed de Guzman (IFP), Bishop Leo Alconga (PJM), Bishop

Noel Pantoja (PCEC) and Bro. Wyden King (NFS). The vision and mission of the Palawan Leaders' Summit is to forge a strong unity in the Body of Christ in the Philippines and through a relationship of love, honor, respect and a culture and spirit of humility and preference for one another, pursue the Lord's destiny and purpose for the nation seizing the "kairos" or most opportune moment in God's dispensation of grace and favor upon the Philippines. The speakers that the conveners invited to minister to the bishops and leaders in Palawan 4 were Dr. David Damien of Vancouver, Canada; Rev. Roy Zhang of Giangzou, China and Rev. Bernie Gilliott of the USA. Dr. David

COVENANT OF LOVE AND UNITY

"If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind." Philipians 2:1-2



One of my most awaited annual event in the Body of Christ, aside from the National Prayer Gathering (NPG) of the Intercessors for the Philippines (IFP), is the Bishops and Leaders' Summit often held at Legend Hotel in Puerto Princesa, Palawan. This unprecedented and almost miraculous annual gathering of top leaders and key bishops in the Body of Christ is personally special to me because of the assignment that the Lord commissioned me during the March 16, 2010 Proclamation of the Year of Jubilee of the Philippines (PYJP) held at Cebu International Convention Center (CICC) proclaiming prophetically our 490th Year since the discovery of the Philippines and the planting of the cross in Cebu Island making us the first Christian nation in Asia. For the past 5 years, we have held this IFP-initiated event four times, three of which (Palawan 1, 2 and 4) were held in Palawan and one (Palawan 3) at Canyon Woods near the Tagaytay-Batangas border. The conveners of these Leaders' Summit are IFP, PCEC, PJM and NFS Ministries. Bro. Wyden and Sister Antonia King always sponsor the expenses of these gatherings while IFP serves as the secretariat.

Every one of these Leaders' Summit was graced by a mighty visitation of the Lord enabling the bishops and leaders to overcome all odds and accomplish unprecedented transformation in our hearts as follows, namely: Palawan 1 in May, 2012 – Reconciliation and Friendship among the leaders; Palawan 2 in May 2013- Baptism of the Heavenly Father's Love; Palawan 3 in November 2015- The Leaders covenanted to be married to the Land (Philippines); Palawan 4 in November 2016- the Bishops and Leaders covenanted to be "married" or bonded to each other in love and unity sealing the symbolic act with a ring ceremony. It is also in this just concluded Palawan 4 that all the 96 participants agreed to be one family committed to love, honor, bless and serve one another under one Heavenly Father.

As in Palawan 3, I invited again Dr. David Damien and Pastor Roy Zhang to be our retreat speakers ministering to the ministers the messages of the Lord. I also invited Rev. Bernie Gilliott to share about the ministry of Global Teen Challenge and link with us to help us in our plan to help the government in ministering to and rehabilitating drug surrenderies. Dr. David and Pastor Roy Zhang emphasized the need to be united together as a big spiritual family with the fathers or the senior leaders of the church and the sons and daughters or the younger leaders of the church flowing together in advancing the Kingdom of God and pursuing the destiny of the nation. With the broad spectrum of the Body of Christ including the vital presence of some key leaders the Filipino-Chinese churches, the Lord once again moved mightily as everyone joined in the covenant of love and unity as one big family to advance the Kingdom of God in our nation and lay down whatever we have for the Lord to move mightily and fulfill the destiny of the nation. The covenant was sealed with a ring ceremony for more than 90 leaders, the nice covenant rings of different sizes donated by Pastor Roy Zhang. The Lord indeed is good encouraging us powerfully that despite the present challenges we face in the government, we will overcome and come out victorious in the end because for the first time, the family has come together! and Rev. Roy represents the Homecoming Ministries while Rev. Bernie represents the Global Teen Challenge.

This is the fourth great gathering of bishops and spiritual leaders in the past five years since the Lord spoke strongly about the need to unite and come together as one Body of Christ in March 16, 2010 Jubilee Proclamation in Cebu when the Prophet Sadhu Sundar Selvaraj said that: *"You are not ready for your Jubilee because you are divided, you fight each other; you fight each other in the internet..."* Bro. Sadhu made an altar call and Bishop Dan along with more than 3,000 pastors came to the front and cried out to God with a loud voice and wails of repentance filled the Cebu International Convention Center auditorium. While this was going on, the Lord showed Bishop Dan a vision of a bamboo split but still connected at the bottom. The Lord then commissioned him to put the bamboo together and tie a rope at the end with a word of reassurance: *"I am going to heal the break!"* The succeeding 3-Day National Fasting and Prayers last April 21, 2010, immediately following the proclamation of Jubilee, became the stage of the historic public reconciliation and foot washing at Rizal Memorial Baseball Stadium where the seven bishops from Philippines Council of Evangelical Churches (PCEC) and seven bishops from Philippines for Jesus Movement (PJM) washed each other's feet. That single event broke the enmity between the national church leaders and paved the way for the tremendous breakthrough in unity and love among the bishops and leaders in the Body of Christ. Guided by the Holy

Spirit, these initiatives led to the annual Bishops and Leaders' Summit mostly held at Legend Hotel in Puerto Princesa, Palawan later called Palawan 1, 2, 3 and 4. Out of the four historic gatherings of top and key bishops and leaders in the Body of Christ, only Palawan 3 was held outside of Puerto Princesa but at Canyon Woods near the boundary of Tagaytay and Batangas. In Palawan 1, the bishops and leaders signed the Palawan Covenant pledging that they will not allow political nor theological differences divide them again. This became the foundation of the succeeding Bishops and Leaders Summits as the Lord unites the church fathers in love and unity.

Palawan 4 marked the birth of the acceptance of the bishops and leaders that the Body of Christ is one big family under Father God. It also unveiled strategic significance of the Philippines and the Philippine church in bringing many nations in Asia and the rest of the world into the Kingdom of God. The highlight and climax of the gathering was the covenant of unity among the leaders sealed with a touching ring ceremony signifying that they are joined to one another as brothers and sisters in the love of the Father and also, as a token of being "married to the Land" (Isaiah 62: 4-7). Aside from powerful and anointed teaching sessions by the speakers and testimonies, bonding times like games of basketball, team building activities and a day at the beautiful Pandan Island at Honda Bay spiced the Leaders' Summit to further enhance and strengthen personal relationships. The Lord moved mightily that everyone looks forward to Palawan 5.
